2026 NATIONAL BEEF CATTLE SUPPLIER AFFIDAVIT

The undersigned certifies that during our ownership, and to the best of our knowledge prior to our ownership, none of the cattle described herein are adulterated within the meaning of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (*i.e.*, none of the cattle or other ruminants are fed feedstuffs containing protein derived from mammalian tissues, *e.g.* meat and bone meal) not in compliance with 21 CFR 589.2000. In addition, none of the cattle have illegal and/or volatile levels of drug residues and that all cattle shipped to National Beef meet or exceed the recommended withdrawal time for any/all drugs/antibiotics/feed additives/etc. that may have been administered. Supplier agrees to use good judgement and discretion to ensure the judicious use of medically important drugs. In addition, all cattle marketed to National Beef are grain fed (for a minimum of 90 days) from a cattle supplier (feed yard, sale barn, farmer-feeder, ect.) that has at least one key management person on staff that is BQA certified.
